Reunification Procedures - When a known threat enters one of our schools, the top priority is safety of our students. After assessing the threat, the next goal is to reunite children safely and strategically with their parents. This is a normal part of all threat response for the schools and a positive case of COVID-19 would initiate these procedures. The primary goal would be to utilize normal dismissal procedures. However, it may become important to reunite you with your child earlier in the day. If you are informed of a positive case in the schools, which will only be communicated through the app ([Android](#) or [iOS](#)), follow these procedures.

- First, and most importantly, **STAY HOME** and await further instructions. (Salida School District is not equipped with the resources to facilitate a mass reunification between all students and parents at one time.)
- Wait for specific instructions about when and where you will be able to retrieve your student.
- Arrive at your designated check point, get in the traffic line, and stay in your vehicle as runners from the school will work to reunite parents with their students.
- Law enforcement will help manage traffic, while school staff will bring your child to your car.
- Be patient. Stay calm. We will go as slow as necessary to reunite children with their families in an efficient manner.
